CURRENT ABHA MEMBERSHIP NUMBERS, CURRENT ABHA REGISTRATION NUMBERS, AND PHOTOCOPIES OF LEASE AGREEMENTS IF APPLICABLE ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL ENTRIES.

STABLING- ALL HORSES REMAINING ON THE GROUNDS ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN A STALL/OUTSIDE PEN AVAILABLE ONLY BY RESERVATION. OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL CLEANING, FEEDING, AND WATERING. STALLS MUST BE LEFT CLEAN UPON DEPARTURE.

POST ENTRIES- MUST BE MADE BEFORE THE PRECEDING CLASS ENTERS THE RING, AT THE SHOW OFFICE.

OPEN CHECKS- OPEN CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE START OF THE SHOW FOR POST ENTRIES, BUT NOT FOR INITIAL PAYMENT FOR PRE ENTRY CLASSES. OPEN CHECKS WILL BE HELD AT THE OFFICE AS A COURTESY FOR EXHIBITORS. OPEN CHECKS NOT CLOSED 1 HOUR AFTER THE END OF THE SHOW, WILL BE CHARGED A \$15.00 OFFICE FEE.

SCRATCHED CLASSES- WILL NOT BE REFUNDED WITHOUT A COPY OF A VETERINARY CERTIFICATE FOR PRE ENTRY EXHIBITORS. NO REFUND FOR POST ENTRY EXHIBITORS.

GATE HOLDS- 5 MINUTE MAXIMUM ARE LIMITED TO HORSE/EXHIBITORS IN CONSECUTIVE CLASSES.

NUMBERS- EXHIBITORS MUST BE IN THE RING SUITABLY ATTIRED WITH CORRECT NUMBERS CLEARLY VISIBLE ON EXHIBITORS BACK OR ON LEFT (NEAR) SIDE OF SADDLE PAD. FOR "IN-HAND" CLASSES, THE NUMBER CAN BE PINNED TO FRONT OF EXHIBITOR.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR- IT IS COMPULSORY FOR ALL JUNIOR EXHIBITORS 18 AND UNDER RIDING IN ENGLISH ATTIRE AND/OR ANY AND ALL WARM UP ACTIVITIES ON THE RED TOP PREMISES TO WEAR PROPERLY FITTED AND FASTENED PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR WHICH MEETS ASTM/SEI STANDARDS. JUNIOR EXHIBITORS MAY SHOW IN WESTERN CLASSES WITH COWBOY HAT. ANY EXHIBITOR OF ANY AGE TO WEAR PROPERLY FITTED AND FASTENED PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR WHICH MEETS ASTM/SEI STANDARDS AT ANY TIME WHILE SHOWING OR WARMING UP OVER FENCES ON RED TOP PREMISES. NOTE: NO RIDER OF ANY AGE WILL BE PENALIZED FOR WEARING PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR IN WESTERN/TRAIL/IN HAND CLASSES.

CROSS ENTRIES- CROSS ENTRIES BETWEEN WALK/TROT/JOG CLASSES AND WALK/TROT/JOG/CANTER/LOPE CLASSES ALLOWED.

WESTERN CLASSES- EXHIBITORS ALLOWED TO RIDE TWO HANDS WITH ANY AND ALL BITS.

TRAINING EQUIPMENT- NO TRAINING EQUIPMENT ALLOWED IN ANY CLASS.

ALL DECISIONS OF THE JUDGE/OFFICIALS/MANAGEMENT ARE FINAL.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

MARES AND FOALS CLASS (1)

Mares and Foals to be presented together each with their own handler. Both will need to walk/trot/jog comfortably with their handlers. Mares and foals Part 1 to be judged on conformation, conditioning, and overall reproduction improvement from Mare to Foal. Foals Part 2 to be judged on age-appropriate conformation, Breed standards overall, and body conditioning. Part 1 and Part 2 to be judged consecutively and awarded separately. Mares and Foals should be used to being handled and safe to be approached by judge/class officials. Halter Conformation specifics to be applied.

HALTER CONFORMATION CLASSES (2,3,4,5,6,7,8)

The purpose of the Halter Conformation Class is to present a well mannered horse which reflects a positive combination of balance, structural correctness, and movement with appropriate breed and sex characteristics and adequate muscling. Horse to be judged either Squared stance and/or squared front with stepped forward spread in the rear (right or left hind leg forward acceptable) stance not to exceed 8 inches. The ideal ABHA conformation horse should have a natural breed standard appearance from head to tail. Western attire and appropriate Halter or English attire and appropriate Bridle to be used. Chaps, Spurs prohibited. Horses to be shown in good working halter; Rope, Braided, Nylon, or Leather. No leads with chains allowed. An exhibitor may show only one horse per class.

SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES (9,10,11,12)

Exhibitors will be asked to demonstrate their ability to lead, turn, set up and move their animal as the judge directs. Judge may ask exhibitors to perform other tests. Judges techniques and procedures may vary. The following principles always apply: Individuals tests must be performed with the official involved in the same relative position to each exhibitor. The exhibitor shall not stand directly in front of the horse. The exhibitor shall always lead, back or move the horse from the left (Near) side, unless otherwise specified in the pattern. All turns of 180 degrees or more shall be to the right, with the exhibitor walking to the right around the horse. Forehand turns to either direction are permissible. Horse to be judged either Squared stance and/or squared front with stepped forward spread in the rear (right or left hind leg forward acceptable) stance not to exceed 8 inches. Quartering system is recommended but not mandatory. Judge may penalize at their discretion any exhibitor that does not demonstrate the quartering system. Judged 60% on showmanship and handling, 30% on fitting and grooming, 10% on neatness of handler. Western attire and appropriate Halter or English attire and appropriate Bridle to be used. Chaps, Spurs, and leads with chains prohibited. An exhibitor may only show one horse.

LONGE LINE 3YRS AND UNDER

To be shown in a regular type halter with only a longe line attached by a snap. A longe whip is permitted. Use of a circle is necessary and should be a 25 foot radius. Judge to be outside the longe circle. At the signal each exhibitor will have 90 seconds to present horse, starting either direction. Each horse should demonstrate a walk, jog/trot, canter/lope each direction. Playing on the line not to be penalized. This class is to reward movement, manners, expression/attitude and conformation. Judged as a performance prospect. May be penalized for excessive bucking, charging, or displaying traits undesirable to a performance horse. Exhibitors to remain in the ring after showing. Judged on movement 50%, manners

30%, conformation 20%. Balance and athletic capabilities are to be emphasized. Attire should be that of Halter/Showmanship. An exhibitor may only show one horse.

ROUND PEN FREESTYLE OPEN

At the signal each horse/handler pair are given 3 minutes to perform at liberty in a fully enclosed round pen. Freestyle routines must have, but not limited to maneuvers listed below performed in any order. Judging will consist of each required movement listed below scored 1-10 as well as additional scoring in the categories listed below. Scores to reflect movement, manners, expression/attitude. Handlers are allowed to add any specialized movements (i.e. side pass, small circles, roll backs etc.) and tricks if they choose. These special added maneuvers will reflect in the difficulty score. Top possible score of 110, difficulty score to be used as tie breaker. Attire to be that of Halter/Showmanship.

ENGLISH EQUITATION W/T OPEN

Class to be shown at a walk, trot, on the rail both directions of the arena. Not to canter. Extensions of gait, drop stirrups, halt and back up may be called for. Judged on Equitation overall, hands, seat, and general horsemanship. Suitability of horse/pony to rider will be considered. Horses of any age may be shown in a standard snaffle, bitless headstall. Attire to be suitable to horse type. English jackets, tall English boots, half chaps optional.

ENGLISH EQUITATION OPEN

Class to be shown at a walk, trot, canter, on the rail both directions of the arena, extension of gaits, drop stirrups, halt and back up, may be called for. To be judged on Equitation overall, hands, seat, and general horsemanship. Horses of any age may be shown in a standard snaffle, bitless headstall. Attire to be suitable to horse type. English jackets, tall English boots, half chaps optional.

ENGLISH/DRESSAGE SUITABILITY W/T OPEN

Class to be shown walk, trot both directions of the arena on the rail. Not to canter. Extension of gaits, halt, and back up may be called for. To be judged on ease of gaits, forward motion, willingness, and obedience. Horses of any age to be shown in any English type bit, or bitless headstall. Attire to be suitable to horses type. English Jackets, tall boots, half chaps optional. Horse should suit English/Dressage disciplines.

ENGLISH/DRESSAGE SUITABILITY OPEN

Class to be shown walk, trot, canter both directions of the arena on the rail. Extension of gaits, halt and back up, may be called for. To be judged on ease of gaits, forward motion, willingness, and obedience. Horses of any age to be shown in any English type bit, or bitless headstall. Attire to be suitable to horses type. English Jackets, tall boots, half chaps optional. Horse should suit English/Dressage disciplines.

ENGLISH HORSEMANSHIP W/T OPEN

Class to be shown performing a pattern. Pattern will only include walk, trot. Extended trot and sitting trot may be included. To be judged on the riders ability to execute in concert with their horse, the

prescribed pattern with precision and smoothness while exhibiting poise, confidence and control. Maintaining proper balance, functional and fundamentally correct body position. Attire to be suitable to horses type. English Jackets, tall boots, half chaps optional.

ENGLISH HORSEMANSHIP OPEN

Class to be shown performing a pattern. Pattern will only include walk, trot, canter. Extended gaits and sitting trot may be included. To be judged on the riders ability to execute in concert with their horse, the prescribed pattern with precision and smoothness while exhibiting poise, confidence and control. Maintaining proper balance, functional and fundamentally correct body position. Attire to be suitable to horses type. English Jackets, tall boots, half chaps optional.

HUNTER HACK GROUND POLES W/T OPEN

To be shown in 2 parts. 1: Flatwork, walk trot both directions of the arena. Extended trot may be called for. 2: Jumping pattern including two jumps (ground poles) stop, and back up may also be asked for. To be judged on even hunter pace, manners, way of going, and jumping style. Flatwork 30%, Fence work 70%. Fence height ground poles only, two fences set at 48 feet apart, 15-18 trot strides between fences. Credit for even strides to the fence and on the rail, even cadence, attentive look, quality of shape over fences, ease of going. Exhibitors must trot over fences. Penalized for incorrect diagonal at the trot, breaking gate, fence refusal, bucking, or bolting. Failure to jump either fence after 3 refusals bypass jumps and continue to finish pattern as prescribed. Attire to be suitable to horses type. English Jackets, tall boots, half chaps optional.

HUNTER HACK 18 INCHES OPEN

To be shown in 2 parts. 1: Flatwork, walk, trot, canter both directions of the arena. Extended gaits including hand gallop may be called for. 2: Jumping pattern including two jumps (not to exceed 18 inches) stop, and back up may also be asked for. To be judged on even hunter pace, manners, way of going, and jumping style. Flatwork 30%, Fence work 70%. Fence height 18 inches, two fences set at 48 feet apart, 3-5 canter strides between fences. Credit for even strides to the fence and on the rail, even cadence, attentive look, quality of shape over fences, ease of going. Exhibitors must canter over fences. Penalized for incorrect diagonal at the trot, wrong lead at the canter, breaking gait, fence refusal, bucking, or bolting. Failure to jump either fence after 3 refusals bypass jumps and continue to finish pattern as prescribed. Attire to be suitable to horses type. English Jackets, tall boots, half chaps optional.

WESTERN EQUITATION W/J OPEN

Class to be shown at a walk, jog on the rail both directions of the arena. Not to canter. Extended jog, halt and back up may be called for. Judged on Equitation overall, hands, seat, and general horsemanship. Suitability of horse/pony to rider will be considered. Horses of any age may be shown in a standard western bit, snaffle, standard rawhide hackamore, or bitless headstall. Attire to be suitable to horses type. Cowboy hats, chaps/chinks optional.

WESTERN EQUITATION OPEN

Class to be shown at a walk, jog, lope on the rail both directions of the arena, extension of gaits, halt and back up may be called for. Judged on Equitation overall, hands, seat, and general horsemanship. Horses of any age may be shown in a standard western bit, snaffle, standard rawhide hackamore, or bitless headstall. Attire to be suitable to horses type. Cowboy hats, chaps/chinks optional.

WESTERN/RANCH SUITABILITY W/J OPEN

Class to be shown walk, jog, both directions of the arena on the rail. Not to canter. Extended jog, halt, back up, turns on forehand or haunches, may be called for. To be judged on ease of gaits, forward motion, willingness, obedience. Horses of any age may be shown in standard western bit, snaffle, standard rawhide hackamore or bitless headstall. Two hands allowed with all bits. Attire to be suitable to horses type. Cowboy hats, chaps/chinks optional. Horse should suit Western/Ranch disciplines.

WESTERN/RANCH SUITABILITY OPEN

Class to be shown walk, jog, lope both directions of the arena on the rail. Extension of gaits, halt, back up, turns on forehand or haunches, may be called for. To be judged on ease of gaits, forward motion, willingness, obedience. Horses of any age may be shown in standard western bit, snaffle, standard rawhide hackamore or bitless headstall. Attire to be suitable to horses type. Cowboy hats, chaps/chinks optional. Horse should suit Western/Ranch disciplines.

WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP W/J OPEN

Class to be shown performing a pattern. Pattern will include walk, jog. Extended jog, halt, back, turns on forehand and/or haunches, and sidepass may be called for. Not to canter. To be judged on the riders ability to execute in concert with their horse, the prescribed pattern with precision and smoothness while exhibiting poise, confidence and control. Maintaining proper balance, functional and fundamentally correct body position. Horses of any age may be shown in standard western bit, snaffle, standard rawhide hackamore or bitless headstall. Attire to be suitable to horses type. Cowboy hats, chaps/chinks optional.

WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP OPEN

Class to be shown performing a pattern. Pattern will include walk, jog, lope. Extended gaits, halt, back, turns on forehand and/or haunches, and sidepass may be included. To be judged on the riders ability to execute in concert with their horse, the prescribed pattern with precision and smoothness while exhibiting poise, confidence and control. Maintaining proper balance, functional and fundamentally correct body position. Horses of any age may be shown in standard western bit, snaffle, standard rawhide hackamore or bitless headstall. Attire to be suitable to horses type. Cowboy hats, chaps/chinks optional.

ADVANCED PERFORMANCE OPEN (E/W)

To be shown walk, trot, jog, canter, lope and as the Judge directs, both directions of the arena. Tests may include, but not limited to: gallop, collect or extend any gait, turn on the forehand and/or haunches, halt, back, sidepass, and perform any other tests indicative of a higher trained performance horse. If a reverse at the canter/lope is called for exhibitor shall reverse and proceed on the lead specified by the Judge. All horses must be allowed to attempt all required tests. Not all tests listed are required. Horses should be agile, athletic, supple, prompt, willing, and show impulsion with calmness and good manners. Judged on performance and manners. Attire to be suitable to match horse type. English jackets, tall boots, half chaps, Cowboy hats, chaps/chinks optional.

REINING OPEN

To be shown to prescribed pattern. Attire to be suitable to match horse type, Cowboy hats, chaps/chinks optional.

TRAIL IN HAND 3 YRS AND UNDER (E/W)

The handler will lead/guide horses through, over, and around the obstacles. Touching horse will be penalized but not disqualified. Horse shall be shown in a standard halter, rope halter, and lead. To be shown at walk and trot. Obstacles according to prescribed pattern. Western attire or English attire

suitable to horse type. Chaps, Spurs, and leads with chains prohibited. An exhibitor may only show one horse.

TRAIL IN HAND OPEN (E/W)

The handler will lead/guide horses through, over, and around the obstacles. Touching horse will be penalized but not disqualified. Horse shall be shown in a standard halter, rope halter, and lead. To be shown at walk and trot. Obstacles according to prescribed pattern. Western attire or English attire suitable to horse type. Chaps, Spurs, and leads with chains prohibited. An exhibitor may only show one horse.

TRAIL OPEN (E/W)

To be shown over, through and around obstacles at a walk, jog/trot. Extended gaits, stops, pivots, and back may be called for. Judged on horses willingness to perform tasks they may encounter on the trail. Obstacles according to prescribed pattern. Western attire or English attire suitable to horse type. Exhibitor may only show one horse.

RANCH TRAIL OPEN

To be shown over, through and around obstacles at a walk, jog, lope. Extended gaits, stops, pivots, and back may be called for. To be judged on a horses versatility and willingness to perform tasks they may encounter on the ranch. Natural appearing obstacles, mount/dismount (mounting block to be provided), drag logs and move items according to prescribed pattern. Attire suitable to horse type. Exhibitor may only show one horse.

RIDE A FIVER OPEN (BAREBACK)

To be shown walk, trot and as the judge directs, both directions of the arena. Halt, back up, extension of gaits may be called for. Canter/lope to be used as a tie breaker only. Exhibitors to place a Five (5) Dollar bill (to be provided by each exhibitor) as directed by the Judge under their thigh, if rider loses their bill, instant elimination. The last person to remain with bill in place wins the pot. Exhibitors should be able to perform Judges directions bareback safely and with control.
